Educational goals	The PhD course aims to enable participants to develop theoretical and methodological knowledge, in a multidisciplinary approach, on the topic of the relationship between law and service sector, with particular attention to the legal framework of the services, due to their increasing differentiation and the role undertaken in contemporary economies. Several scientific-disciplinary areas of legal field are involved: private law and private comparative law, commercial law, constitutional law, public law, tax law,

	<p>international law, European Union law, civil procedure, philosophy of law. The program envisages in the first two years the compulsory attendance of lectures and seminars on specific subjects of the course (companies and contracts which have as their subjectmatter the provision of services, consumer protection, services of general economic interest and content and limits of the so-called universal services, services law in the health and logistic sector, tourism law, media and telecommunications law, tax system related to innovative and technological services, European framework concerning Freedom of establishment and freedom to provide services, contracts related to international services, comparative analysis between different systems, ways of protection of rights affected during the provision of services). The course will continue during the third year with an intensive research activity, placed side by side with the participation in thematic seminars. In addition, the PhD program provides some lectures and seminars to be held in English. PhD students will be also encouraged to spend up to 18 months in universities and foreign research institutions, in particular those which are part of the consortium, by using the resources destined for these activities (eg. extra money for abroad experiences,...), whether for research or training activities.</p>

Participation requirements	<p>Possession of one of the following qualifications: Master's Degree (Laurea Magistrale) or a unique cycle Master's Degree or an equivalent title. In the latter case, if the title has not been declared equivalent to the Italian title required, the admission to the competition is subjected to the recognition of the title only for the purpose of the admission to the course by the Scientific Board.</p>
Admission exam	<p>The admission exam consists of, in sequence, the evaluation of titles, a written test and an interview. Candidates will be admitted to the interview if they pass the written test with a score of not less than 30/50. The interview will be considered passed with a score of at least 24/40. The candidate must also demonstrate a good knowledge of a foreign language.</p>
Curriculum evaluation	<p>Titles evaluated: - final grade of the degree (up to a maximum of 3 points: final grade of 110 summa cum laude (highest honors) will confer 3 points; 110-109: 2 points; 108-105: 1 point); - postgraduate titles (up to a maximum of 2 points), - scientific publications (up to a maximum of 5 points). For the candidates who will discuss their thesis after the evaluation of the titles and by 31 October 2019, the evaluation of the university career will be as follows: average exam score from 29 to 30: 3 points; from 28 to 28.99: 2 points; from 27 to 27.99: 1 point Written admission test Writing an essay.</p>

Written admission test	Writing an essay chosen among 3 different topics prepared by the commission. The written exam will be held 17/09/2019, at 9.30.
Oral examination	Oral admission test: The interview will consist in a discussion of the essay and of the fundamentals of the services law. The oral admission test will be held on the day 18/09/2018 at 10,00.
