THE RECTOR

- In consideration of** Law No. 168 of May 9, 1989, with special reference to art. 6 and 16;
- In consideration of** Law No. 210 of July 3, 1998, with special reference to art. 4 for Ph.D. regulation;
- In consideration of** Law No. 240 of December 30, 2010 "Norme in materia di organizzazione delle università, di personale accademico e reclutamento, nonché delega al Governo per incentivare la qualità e l'efficienza del sistema universitario";
- In consideration of** the Statute of the "Parthenope" University of Naples, issued with the Rector Decree No. 182 of March 17th, 2020;
- In consideration of** DM n.226/2021 from MUR on "*Regolamento recante modalità di accreditamento delle sedi e dei corsi di dottorato e criteri per la istituzione dei corsi di dottorato da parte degli enti accreditati*";
- Taking into account** that the provisions of these regulations have been implemented by the University and on March 9, 2022, with Dr n. 211, the University Regulations governing the PhD adapted to the new provisions were prepared and issued, further updated with DR n.428/2022;
- Provided** that the deadline for entering doctoral courses for the XXXIX cycle into the Cineca database is June 5, 2023;
- Taking into account** that the MUR issued two decrees representing to universities the allocation of funding for the provision of additional PhD scholarships from PNRR;
- In consideration of** the fact that



DM 118/2023 has assigned to University Parthenope for a.y. 23/24, based on PNRR funds:

- N. 4 scholarships for PhDs in programs dedicated to digital and environmental transitions;
- N. 25 scholarships for PNRR research doctorates;
- N. 22 scholarships for doctorates for the Public Administration;
- N. 4 PhD scholarships for cultural heritage.

The total funded by the MUR attached to this DM is 55 scholarships whose total cost is 3,060,000.00 euros so each scholarship is expected to be funded at 60,000 euros;

DM 117/2023 has assigned to University Parthenope for a.y. 22/23, based on PNRR funds:

- N. 134 scholarships for innovative doctorates that meet the innovation needs of enterprises and promote the recruitment of researchers from enterprises. In the latter case, however, the 134 planned scholarships must provide for each scholarship to be disbursed a co-funding of 50 percent of the Ministerial endowment from enterprises, so the MUR funding turns out to be 4,020,000.00 euros.

In consideration of	the proposals for the activation of doctoral courses presented by the Departments;
In consideration of	the resolutions of the Academic Senate, meeting of May 31, 2023, and the Board of Directors, meeting of June 1, 2023, approving the activation of the XXXIX cycle doctoral courses, the funding of scholarships as well as the places without scholarships and the distribution of resources from PNNR DM117 and 118;
Taking into account	that proposals for the establishment/renewal of doctoral courses have been entered into the appropriate database for application for accreditation;
Taking into account	that doctoral courses although established, can only be activated following ministerial accreditation;
In execution	of what was deliberated;



Having regard to the current Statute of the "Parthenope" University of Naples;

DECREES

ART. 1 - ACTIVATION OF PH.D. PROGRAMS - XXXIX CYCLE

At the University of Naples "Parthenope, in compliance with the Regulation on the modalities for the accreditation of doctoral seats and courses and criteria for the establishment of doctoral courses by accredited institutions, the following doctoral courses XXXIX cycle are activated:

1. Ambiente, risorse e sviluppo sostenibile
2. Information and Communication Technology and Engineering
3. Energy Science and engineering
4. Diritto e istituzioni economico-sociali: profili normativi, organizzativi e storico-evolutivi
5. Economics, Management and Accounting
6. Scienze delle attività motorie e sportive -
7. Economia statistica e sostenibilità
8. Studi linguistici, terminologici ed interculturali
9. Fenomeni e rischi ambientali
10. Il diritto dei servizi nell'ordinamento italiano ed europeo
11. Imprenditorialità e Innovazione

ART. 2 - ADMISSION AND AVAILABLE POSITIONS

Public competitive examinations are announced in accordance with the procedures set out in the annexes to this notice, for admission to the doctoral courses referred to in Article 1 above. The essential features of each doctorate and the places offered for competition for each doctoral course are given in Annexes Nos. 1-11 to this decree of which they form an integral and substantial part.

DEADLINE FOR THE APPLICATION

31 July 2023

The exam tests are defined in the annexes and will be held in September 2023

The positions are divided in 5 categories:

If there is additional funding, they are indicated in the attached Annexes or will be communicated by the dates set for the selection tests by means of a notice published on the University website.

There may also be other positions reserved for other categories, eg. "Holders of research grants and winners of EU projects"; these positions will be indicated in the Annexes and will related exclusively to the PhD course to which they refer.

ART. 3 - ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

PhD positions are open for students, without limitation of citizenship, holding an Italian degree "Laurea magistrale" or equivalent title (second level or master degree) from a recognized foreign institution, or by those who will obtain it by date of the enrollment to the PhD program.

The validity of a foreign degree is assessed by the Examining Committee of the PhD program, in compliance with the regulations in force in Italy and in the issuing country and international treaties or agreements on the recognition of degrees for further study.

Applicants that will not obtain their degree by the date of the enrollment to the PhD program will be excluded.

In the event that the candidate participates to the competition before having obtained the degree, the admission will be "conditional" and the applicant will be required to submit the relevant degree certificate by the due date for course registration.

ART. 4 - APPLICATIONS

Applications for the call, to be made exclusively online by accessing the platform <https://pica.cineca.it/uniparthenope/dr502-dottorato-39-ciclo/> must be completed **no later than the dates indicated in Article 2.**

In case the day set for the deadline to receive the applications is not a working day, the deadline is extended to the first following working day.

The application must be submitted expressly stating the doctoral course and type of position in which one intends to participate under penalty of exclusion from selection.

The application must be accompanied by all the documentation related to the chosen doctoral course as specified in the individual sheets on doctoral courses attached to this notice, under penalty of exclusion from selection.

The platform allows you to participate only for one position per doctoral course by indicating only one category so in case you intend to compete for more than one doctoral course, multiple applications must be submitted in the platform.

The application prepared under the responsibility of the candidate himself or herself under penalty of exclusion from the competition, must contain the following statements:

- a) last name (maiden name for married women), first name, date and place of birth; country of citizenship; country of residence and permanent address; National Identification Number (e.g., in Italy fiscal code; in USA Social Security Number or Tax code);
- b) the name of the selected PhD Program to which the applicant wants to apply;
- c) the exact name of the qualification held, indicating the date it was obtained and the University that issued it or the equivalent qualification obtained at a foreign University, as well as the date of the decree by which the equivalence itself was declared. (In the event that the candidate has yet to acquire the degree on the date of submission of the application, he/she must declare that such achievement will take place within the deadlines stipulated in this notice, under penalty of exclusion from the selection and disqualification from any ranking).

Applicants with a foreign academic degree that has not yet been declared equivalent to one of the required Italian degrees must attach to the application the following documents useful to enable the Selection Committee to declare eligibility for participation in the doctoral program:

1. *Copy of the academic degree obtained abroad comparable in duration, level and topics to the Italian degree that enables access to the course;*
2. *Declaration of value on site or certificate of comparability of the ENIC-NARIC centers and any other documentation useful for assessing the eligibility of the degree held for the chosen course **to be transmitted by the dates indicated below:***
3. *Certificate with exams taken and marks (transcript of records), possibly indicating the value scale to which the marks refer;*
4. *Diploma supplement and/or translation of the documents indicated in points 1 and 3 into Italian or English, if issued in a different language.*

Documents 1, 3, 4 must be attached to the application form, otherwise the candidate will be excluded.

The documentation referred to in item 2 if not yet in the possession of the candidate at the time of application must be submitted under penalty of forfeiture of the doctorate itself by the date of registration for the course.

The Declaration of Value can be replaced by the Certificate of comparability of the foreign university title issued by the ENIC-NARIC center in Italy (CIMEA) which contains all the information necessary for the evaluation of the qualification.

- d) to commit to full-time attendance of the doctoral course in accordance with the terms



- to be determined by the board of teachers;
- e) the foreign languages known and the foreign language chosen for the oral test, if any;
 - f) to take a leave of absence in case one is an employee of Public Administrations;
 - g) that he/she does not exceed the income limit provided for the use of the scholarship in case one chooses the category place with scholarship or place with scholarship financed by DM 117/2022 or 118/ 2022
 - h) to have/have not previously benefited from another scholarship (even for only one year) for a doctoral course;
 - i) to commit to go abroad in case it is foreseen by the doctoral course, by the type of scholarship chosen and by the faculty of the course itself;
 - j) to declare the type/category of position in which one intends to participate:
 - (A) Position with scholarship;
 - (B) Position funded by DM 117;
 - (C) Position funded by DM 118;
 - (D) Position without scholarship;
 - (E) Position reserved to a company employee;
 - (F) Any other places indicated as reserved in the annexes to the announcement of individual doctoral courses;
 - k) to have read the present call for admission;
 - l) to declare, in the case there are positions reserved to research fellows, the duration of the grant equivalent at least to the entire duration of the doctoral course;
 - m) the address elected for the purposes of the competition specifying the postal code, telephone number and e-mail address, if any, with express mention of the commitment to communicate promptly any change of the same. Possibly for EU and foreign citizens, an Italian address or the indication of their Embassy in Italy, elected as domicile.

Applicants must also attach to the application the following:

- a copy of a valid ID card
- a filled form for possible other funding schemes

All requests for possible other funding schemes are considered after the merit ranking of the competitive examination is published on the University website.

Under existing legislation, applicants with disabilities must specify in their application the assistance required in relation to their handicap and the possible need for additional time for the completion of the Competitive exams.



All applicants who:

- will not have gained a required degree **by the dates indicated in art. 3**
- having foreign qualifications have not brought the required documents by the dates indicated in Article 3 and 4 of this announcement

will be excluded.

The Administration may in any stage of the recruitment process, decide of the exclusion of the candidate for lack of requirements.

The administration assumes no responsibility for the failure of the online platform dependent on an error attributable to the candidate, or any mishaps attributable to the acts of a third party, fortuitous event or force majeure.

ART. 5 – SELECTION

The selection tests are designed to ascertain the candidate's preparation, aptitude for scientific research, and knowledge of one or more foreign languages.

The terms of the admission examination for the chosen doctoral course are outlined in the relevant annex.

The examinations will be held according to the days and procedures indicated in the schedule for each Doctorate (Annexes Nos. 1 to 11 of this notice).

This notice shall have the legal value of notification for all legal purposes.

The venue of the examinations, as well as any other communications regarding the conduct of the competitive examinations, will be made known through the official website of the University <http://www.uniparthenope.it/>

ART. 6 – EXAMINATION COMMITTEE

The Selection Boards, unique per each doctoral program, will be formed and appointed by the Rector, after consultation with the respective Colleges of Professors.

The Selection Boards for the competitive examination for admission to PhD courses are each composed of three members chosen from among tenured university professors and researchers also from other universities, from the scientific-disciplinary fields to which the course refers and belonging to the Teachers' Board.

In the presence of PhD courses in consortium or in agreement with other university institutions or research bodies, Italian or foreign, or in the presence of PhDs in which several curricula are provided, the Selection Board may be composed of five members belonging to the Teaching Board.

No more than two experts, including foreigners, chosen from public and private research organizations and facilities, may be added to the Selection Boards.

To this end, at the expiration of the call for applications, the Board of Professors, proposes in equal number the names of the full members of the Commission and the alternates according to the procedures provided in the current Regulations.



The Chairman of the Commission is the first-rank professor with the most seniority in the role, if any, or the second-rank professor with the most seniority in the role. Secretary is the researcher, if any, or the second-rank professor with less seniority in the role.

The suitability of the foreign degree is ascertained by the doctoral committee in compliance with the relevant regulations in force in Italy and in the country where the degree was awarded and with international treaties or agreements on the recognition of degrees for the pursuit of studies.

The procedures for admission to the doctoral course are defined in the appropriate annexes.

The selection board within 3 days of the completion of the competition tests draws up the merit rankings differentiated by category on the basis of the sum of the marks obtained by each candidate in the individual tests and transmits the relevant minutes to the Magnificent Rector, who within 10 days from the date of receipt provides for the approval of the acts.

From the approvals of the acts, any appeals may be proposed within the following three days.

ART.7 – MERIT RANKINGS

The merit ranking for each doctoral course shall be separate for the categories put up for competition by this announcement.

These will be approved by a single Rectoral Decree per doctorate.

In the event of a tie between two or more candidates, the youngest candidate in age will have precedence in the ranking.

For candidates participating in the scholarships co-funded by DM 117/118, the rankings and scholarship awards must be completed by October 5, 2023 in order to be entered into the database, so successful candidates for these scholarships must register no later than September 25. In case the places advertised for these types are not filled within 3 days from the date of registration, the specific ranking will be scrolled.

For all other categories :

from October 15 to October 31 onwards the winners resulting from the ranking list approved by Rectoral Decree must enroll in the doctoral program under penalty of exclusion from the course.

From Nov. 5 to Nov. 10 onwards, all students resulting eligible must consult the website www.uniparthenope.it on which any notices will be published with the actual number of places that will still be available.

Those who, according to the order of ranking following the published notices, are in a useful position must within 7 days of such publication confirm or not to the pec address: concorsi@pec.uniparthenope.it or to the e-mail address: ufficio.dottorati@uniparthenope.it that they want to enroll in the doctoral course for which they have competed (in the second case they must attach a photocopy of the ID Card).



The office after verifying, according to the order of the ranking list this possibility of sliding by November 20 will publish another notice concerning the eligible admitted by sliding who must by November 30 finalize the enrollment.

In the event that there are no eligible candidates in the ranking in the posts with scholarship co funded by DM 117/118 2023 it will be possible to allocate the aforementioned post(s) with scholarship and subsequent resolution of the teaching board, to the eligible candidates usefully placed in the ranking in the category of posts with scholarship according to the order of the ranking.

In case there are still remaining places beyond these dates, the Academic Senate in the first useful session may possibly further extend the application deadlines but not beyond December 31, unless the new places are derived from ministerial competitive calls.

ART. 8 - ENROLLMENT

Successful applicants must submit or have submitted - under penalty of forfeiture - to the PhD Office of the University of Naples "Parthenope" - Palazzina Spagnola, I Piano Via Acton, 38, Naples from Monday to Friday from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m., the application for enrollment in the course according to the form issued by the administration itself and also available on the University's website <http://www.uniparthenope.it>.

Those who have failed to regularize their enrollment within the above-mentioned peremptory deadlines will be declared disqualified; those who have made false statements will be declared disqualified and the vacancies will be assigned to other aspirants who follow in the list of eligible candidates.

The University Administration has no responsibility for the case of loss of communications, dependent on inaccurate information of domicile on the part of the candidate or failure or delay in communicating the change thereof nor for any postal or telegraphic misunderstandings through no fault of the Administration itself.

ART. 9- SCHOLARSHIPS

The scholarships, the annual amount of which provided for by Ministerial Decree 247 of February 23, 2022 is € 16,243.00 gross of social security charges borne by the recipient and will be subject to the payment of the INPS contribution referred to in Article 2, paragraph 26, of Law August 8, 1995, no. 335 are awarded, after comparative evaluation of merit and according to the order defined in the respective rankings formulated by the Selection Boards.

Any additional scholarships due to funding granted by external public or private entities related **to specific projects or areas of research**, may be granted to eligible students in the rankings according to the procedures defined by the Academic Senate that will be announced through notices published on the university website provided that there is capacity in the places provided by the doctoral course in the database

It should be noted that the scholarships, whose funding already forfeited by the University that depend on EU and international projects relevant to doctoral programs, may, within the



first year of the course through specific procedures, be allocated to the chosen doctoral course.

The winner(s) of such specific procedures, if it is not possible to enter the funding and increase the number of places in the database, will be enrolled in the course of the year in the doctoral program as a supernumerary.

Any increase in the number of scholarships will be announced exclusively by notice on the University's website <http://www.uniparthenope.it/>.

The duration of the scholarship is equal to the entire duration of the course.

Those who have used a scholarship for a doctoral course cannot apply for a second time

Doctoral scholarships cannot be combined with other scholarships for any reason conferred except with those granted by national or foreign institutions useful for integrating the doctoral student's research activity with stays abroad.

The amount of the scholarship is increased for any period of stay abroad to the extent of 50%, and this amount is also intended for winners of places without a scholarship.

For the purposes of the above increase, the faculty of the doctoral course must authorize the period of study abroad and transmit this authorization to the Rector accompanied by a statement that the activity for which the doctoral student's mobility is requested falls within the scope of the implementation of the study and research program formulated at the time.

All doctoral students who are awarded positions with a fellowship or without a fellowship are assured an annual research activity budget in the amount of 10% of the fellowship.

Payment of the scholarship is made in monthly installments for its use the limit of total annual personal income, the amount of which is equal to the annual amount of the scholarship, which is 16,243.00 Euro.

Contributing to the determination of this income is income of patrimonial origin as well as emoluments of any other nature of a recurring nature with the exclusion of those of an occasional nature.

Those who are entitled to the scholarship must also submit at the time of enrollment a presumptive declaration regarding the total gross personal income and the absence of the causes of incompatibility contained in this paragraph. This declaration must be repeated at the beginning of each subsequent year of course attendance. Scholarship recipients must, in addition, arrange for the establishment of an INPS contribution position, enrolling in the "Separate Management" of the same Institute.

ART. 10- POSITIONS RESERVED TO COMPANY EMPLOYEES

The number of places reserved for company employees are defined in Annexes No. 1-11 related to each doctoral course.

Candidates who are employees of the Company/Enterprise/Body will participate in the same selection as other candidates and will be evaluated by the same Commission. At the end of the selection, a specific ranking will be drawn up for this category.

The winners of the selection will be able to proceed to matriculation according to the ordinary procedures defined in Articles 6 and 7 of this announcement.



ART. 11 – CONTRIBUTION TO ACCESS AND ATTEND PROGRAMS

Paragraph 262 of the 2017 Stability Law stipulates "Students on PhD courses who are not recipients of scholarships are exempt from the payment of fees or contributions to the University" therefore both scholarship and non-scholarship students will only have to make the following payment:

regional fee for the DSU (at the time of enrollment of each year of the PhD course) of the amount corresponding to one of three bands according to the economic condition of the student commensurate with the level of the Indicator of Equivalent Economic Situation (ISEEU) and namely:

(a) **120 euros** for those who present an ISEEU value less than or equal to that provided by the eligibility requirements for access to scholarships (ISEEU < 20,220.00 euros) and for students belonging to developing countries ex art. 13 paragraph 5 DPCM April 9, 2001 (D.M. n. 351 of May 3, 2018);

(b) **140 euros** for those who present an ISEEU value higher than the minimum level and up to twice the minimum level provided by the eligibility requirements for access to scholarships (20,220.01 euros < ISEEU < 40,440.00 euros) and for students with a household residing abroad;

(c) **160 euros** for those with an ISEEU value greater than twice the minimum level provided by the eligibility requirements for access to scholarships (ISEEU > 40,440.01) and for those without an ISEEU statement at the time of payment of the fee.

ART. 12 – OBLIGATIONS OF PHD STUDENTS

Doctoral students are obliged to attend doctoral courses in accordance with the procedures and times set by the Board of Teachers by continuously carrying out study and research activities within the facilities designated for this purpose.

ART. 13 – TITLE OF DOCTOR OF RESEARCH

The degree of Ph.D. is conferred by the Rector and is awarded upon passing the final examination.

ART. 14 – INSURANCE

The University guarantees doctoral students, in the performance of their teaching activities, against the insurance risk arising from third-party liability.

It remains, on the other hand, the sole responsibility of the same to provide for the initiation of any insurance coverage against the risk of accidents that may occur during the performance of the aforementioned teaching activities.



ART. 15 – TITLE AWARD

The title of Ph.D. is conferred upon completion of the course by the Rector in accordance with the procedures set forth in Articles 21, 22 and 24 of the University Regulations Governing Ph.D. degrees issued by DR No. 428/2022.

ART. 16 – REFERENCE NORMS

For all that is not provided for in this notice, reference is made to the relevant regulations in force and to the University Regulations governing the doctoral program issued by DR no. 428/2022.

ART. 17- RESPONSIBLE OF THE PROCEDURE

Responsible for any fulfillment inherent to this competition procedure, which is not the responsibility of the Selection Committee is Dr Emmanuele Fiorillo of the PhD Office , via Acton 38, Napoli.

ART. 18 – PERSONAL DATA

The Università degli Studi di Napoli "Parthenope", according to D. Decree 196/2003 and subsequent additions and modifications concerning the provisions on the protection of persons and other subjects, will collect and use the personal data supplied by applicants only for institutional purposes, and for the purpose of selection procedures.

ART. 19 – ADVERTISING

This announcement (with facsimile of the application form) is available on the web site of the "Parthenope" University of Naples <http://www.uniparthenope.it>

ART. 20 – FINAL REGULATION

The assignment of the positions in this call and of the scholarships are subject to the confirmation of accreditation by ANVUR and are subject to the approval by the Ministry.

This decree will be subject to ratification by the University Governing Bodies.
